What we have done

- a) Befriending service has 4 befriendees and 4 volunteers. 9 clients are waiting for a volunteer.
- b) Continued to run tea and chat in Ardgour and Acharacle, Community lunches in Lochaline and Ardgour. Tried Community lunches in Kilchoan and Acharacle. Yoga in Treslaig has continued and trialled in Salen.
- c) Transport continues to grown to 300 journeys in the last year. 18 volunteers, and 90 current users. 15 Car club members.
- d) Expanded the car fleet with two new EV's and taken over the Lochaline EV.
- e) Started the car club in Strontian, expanded to Acharacle and soon to run in Lochaline.
- f) Conducted a questionnaire to see what difference we are making.
- g) Lobbied NHSH to re-recruit for Dail Mhor
- h) Commissioned a district heating feasibility study
- i) Explored housing options with Highland Council.
- j) Submitted a Community Asset Transfer request for the whole building.
- k) Embarked on a Support in the right direction project- improving the independent support and advice available to those accessing social care. Includes the potential for a 'match making' service for those needing personal assistants.
- Developed an idea for a local care model with NHS Highland- next phase is to design the model.

- 2) We need more funding and more volunteers to do more of the same.
- 3) Volunteer recruitment is a big part of the next few months and we will be conducting Drop-in sessions across the peninsulas.
