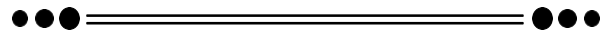
On 16th August, Deputy First Minister Kate Forbes MSP was joined by representatives from all our local Community Councils. A joint recruitment campaign was unanimously agreed to seek to re-open Dail Mhor and boost care provision in people's homes and the community, working in partnership with local care charity – Urram.

Lochaber Care at Home and Local Care Centres

NHS Highland are seeking care workers to staff Dail Mhor as a local Care Centre – full details will be posted on the NHS Highland job portal in September.

We need enough applicants to join a dedicated Dail Mhor team to ensure that it reopens, and remains open, to serve the community. Night or day shifts, half shifts, weekend or 'bank', all considered.

Urram is also trying to build a list of anyone who is interested in paid care work but do not have or want a formal care qualification (e.g. SVQ.), only want to work in their own village, and only have a few hours available. We know of adults who are entitled to a support package and who could fund themselves through "Self Directed Support" Option 1 payments; but who are struggling to find people to help them in their own homes.
